Downloading and installing the program is very simple. After you start the program, it asks you if you want to import favorites, settings, history, and passwords from Internet Explorer or prior versions of Netscape.

If you are like most Internet surfers, chances are you just use Internet Explorer as your favorite browser because it came with your computer. And like most surfers, you have become used to the experience and may have a hard time adjusting to change or you are satisfied so you haven't even thought of switching. Crazy Browser may be the new browser you are looking for because it is so similar to Internet Explorer but the add-ons make it great.
