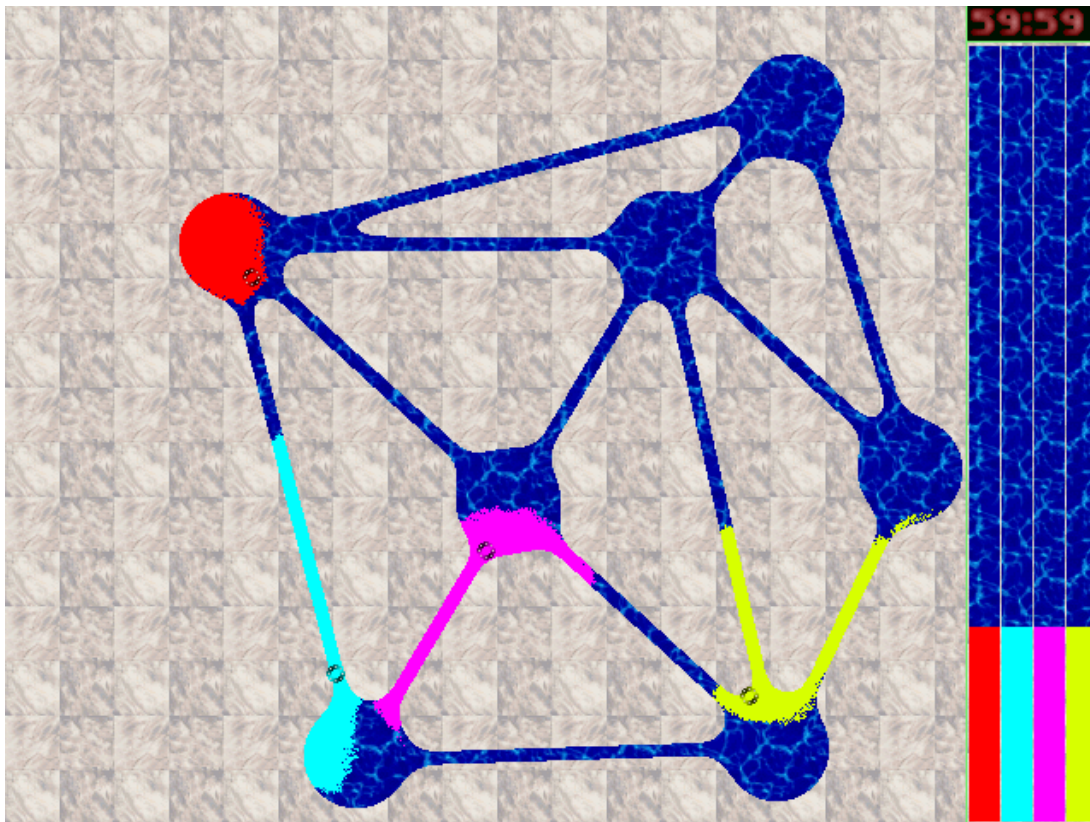

Little Fighter 2 is a popular fighting game for Windows freely downloaded by video game fans.

LF2 was created by Marti Wong and Starsky Wong in 1999, and released in a long series of updates; the latest version, 1.9c, was released on August 19, 2005. The game has proved very popular, thanks in part to its simple yet addictive gameplay, its great replayability and its free availability. The official web site has over 30 million hits and even offers action figures of the main characters via mail order.

The game supports up to 4 human players on one computer, and a total of 8 characters using online play or computer-controlled opponents. Gameplay modes include VS mode, Stage mode (where up to 8 players move through the environment defeating more and more difficult of enemies), Championship mode and Battle mode (involving mass armies led by a player). Characters include Deep, John, Henry, Rudolf, Louis, Firen, Freeze, Dennis, Woody and Davis; additional boss-type characters and enemies from the stage mode can be unlocked via cheat codes, including Julian, Bat, Knight, Jan, and Monk. There are two other secret characters, Firzen and LouisEX, which are unlocked by the cheat code but can also be accessed by performing special actions during the game. Louis, a normal character, can transform into LouisEX if the player presses all action buttons simultaneously when his hp is below 33%; Firzen can be formed by having the normal characters Firen and Freeze run into each other from opposite directions when their hp is below 33%.

Liquid War

Liquid War is a multiplayer wargame based on an original concept by Thomas Colcombet: you move a cursor in a single screen 2D battlefield with some obstacles, and your army of liquid particles follow it using the shortest path. When any particle pushes against an enemy particle, it will fight the enemy and if it fails to fight back will eventually assimilate it. All programming is the work of Christian Mauduit.

Liquid War is a multiplayer game and can be played over the Internet or a LAN. A single player mode is available in which the opponents are controlled by the computer.

Originally a DOS game, Liquid War did not find popularity until the release of version 5.0 in 1998. As of December 2005, the game is at version 5.6.3 and available for DOS, Windows, Mac OS X, GNU/Linux and FreeBSD. Its author has announced that a complete rewrite is in progress to produce version 6.0, which will abandon the Allegro library used for 5.x releases for a full OpenGL implementation.

Liquid War received the Most Original Linux Game award by Happypenguin.org in 2002, and was nominated for the Trophées du libre in 2003, an International Free Software Competition.

Insaniquarium

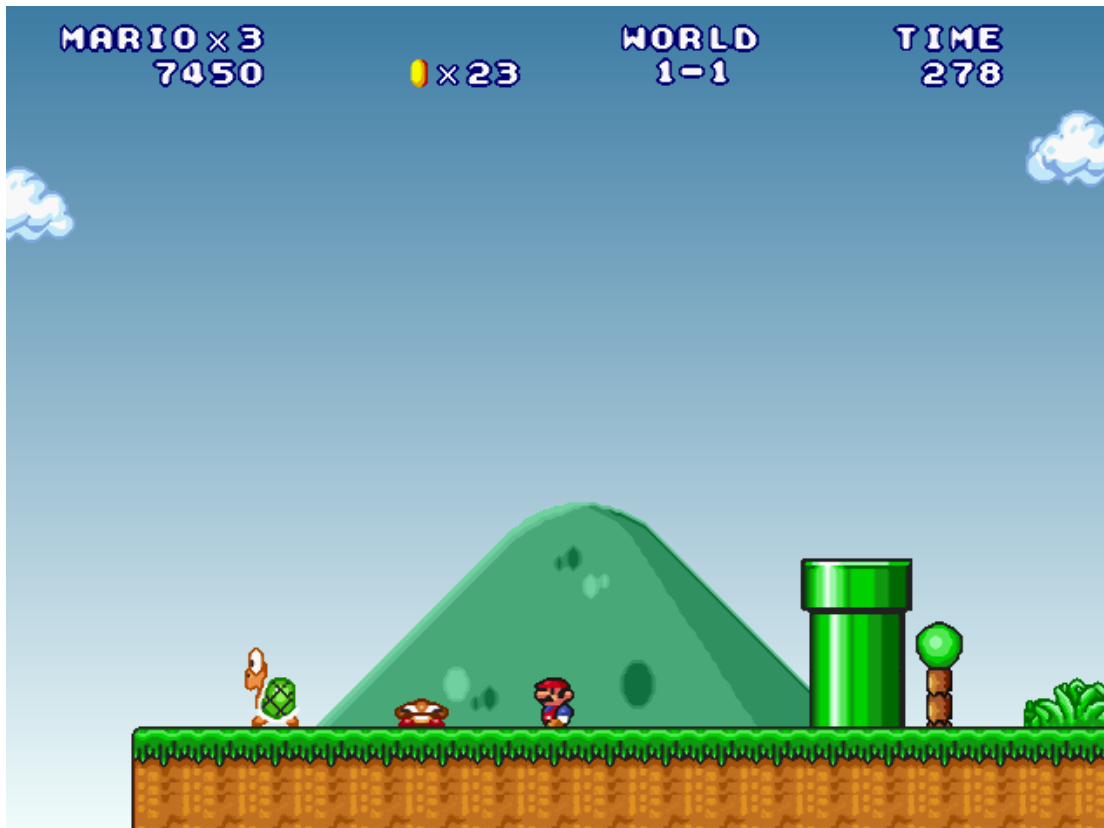

Insaniquarium (Demo Web version) is by Popcap Games in which players strive to keep virtual fish alive, collect coins and other precious objects, and gather upgrades, all while defending their peaceful fishtank against vicious fish-eating aliens. Players gain helpful pets along the way that do various things, like attacking the alien threat, or helping keep their fish fed. If all of a player's fish die, the game is over.

After playing the demo Web version, players may get the complete version for a cost.

Mario Forever is by Burzoil Games and a fan-made remake of the SNES Super Mario All-Stars version of Super Mario Bros. by Buziol Games. It runs on Windows. It features new levels, improved graphics, and some original music and sound effects from various Mario SNES games. It is a program and may be downloaded from various websites with the developers asking for nothing in exchange.

Story

In the peaceful land of the Mushroom Kingdom, the Mushroom People lived peacefully. They lived in their homes and enjoyed their lives, but little did they know, the evil Bowser had come to the Mushroom Kingdom. Bowser had evil intentions of taking over the Mushroom Kingdom. Dink Smallwood

Dink Smallwood is a role playing game published by Robinson Technologies in 1997. The game centers on Dink, a pig farmer turned hero who, after his mother is killed in a tragic fire, embarks on various quests throughout his world. The game features isometric, Zelda-like gameplay, including weapons, items, and magic. The game has a satirical off-color slant, including everything from a fiercely abusive uncle to a town that worships ducks. Dink is never freed from the grievances of being a pig farmer, a fact he is far too often reminded of by his nemesis, Milder Flatstomp.

Storyline

Dink starts out as a pig farmer, living a normal life. His father is said to have disappeared, leaving him behind in a small village with his mother. Somehow, as he is outside, his house burns down, killing his mother. He then is told to go out of his village, into the world to find his aunt, and start living a new life with her. Along the way, he hears of a powerful enemy, Seth, who is trying to take over the world. He becomes determined to defeat Seth, and after he finds his aunt, he starts his mission to defeat him. Eventually, he encounters Seth, and defeats him.

The game comes with its own Dmod, that tells the story of how Dink is ordered to come aboard a ship by the king, after defeating Seth. These Dmods can be heavily customized, and some of them are very different from the original game. The game is open source software.

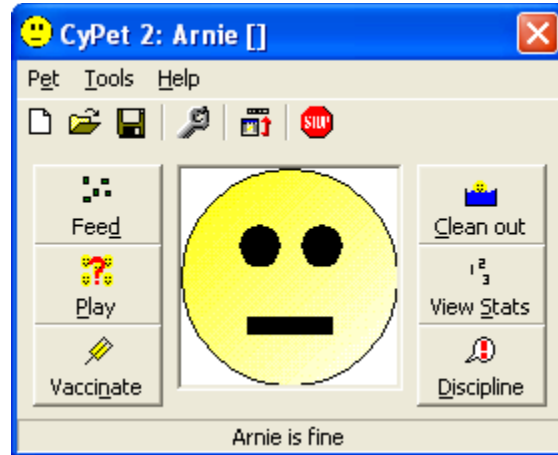
ButterflyHunt
